

2013 Olde Wyve's Tale - Old Vine Carignane

Winemaker's notes

A special wine made for those who want to search outside of the mainstream varietals; this wine is a very pure and bright expression of Carignane. It is completely de-stemmed, fermented with native yeasts and spends 10 months in neutral French oak barrels before going to bottle unfiltered.

Vineyard Sources

Cooley Ranch – Carignane – Alexander Valley (Cloverdale) – Sustainably farmed, head trained and dry farmed, these gnarley old Carignane vines were planted at the Cooley ranch in 1870. Yielding approximately one grape per vine, we're lucky to get any fruit off of our 1.5 acre block. The result is incredibly complex and concentrated fruit with which we love to work.
