Winemaker's notes

The wine is styled after its Provençale cousins from southern France. 100% Mourvedre is thrown whole-cluster into the press where it spends just a few hours macerating on the skins before being pressed off and fermented in a closed top tank. It spends 6 months on the lees before racking, filtration and bottling.

Vineyard Source

Lovett Vineyard – Mourvedre – Lake County (Kelseyville) – Sustainably famed, steep hillside vineyard with north east facing slopes planted in 2005 located on the southern edge of Clear Lake, this vineyard is adjacent to Mount Konocti, a dormant volcano making Clear Lake the largest geothermal area in North America and a desirable region in which to grow high quality wine grapes. The volcanic soil combined with steep slopes offers exceptional drainage and lead to great flavor concentration.
